### MAMATA DENTAL COLLEGE

#### FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT

A questionnaire was prepared to make a survey on various parameters of the institute and the same was filled in the year 2022-2023. The questionnaires consisted of 10 questions for student feedback, 11 questions for teachers feedback, 9 questions for alumni feedback and 10 questions for employer feedback and 11 questions for parents feedback respectively. All the questions were based primarily on teaching learning process, behaviour/conduct, infrastructure, initiatives/grievances etc. The responses for the year were analyzed in order to take corrective actions in relation to institutional vision and goals. The student feedback approach is basically about institutional practices, processes and frameworks that take into account students concerns of the quality of the education they receive. The response of this feedback-form consisted of options and they were asked to select any one option. In the given survey held in 2022-23, the college collected the feedback from around 375 (students), 20 (employers), 100 (alumni) and 58 (teachers) and 92 (parents). 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







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



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



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





Graph 4: The courses / syllabi of the subjects taught by me increased my interest, knowledge and perspective in the subject area.







Graph 6: I have the freedom to adopt new techniques / strategies oftesting and assessment of students'















Graph 11: The classrooms are cleaned and well equipped and maintained'





Graph 1: How do you rate relevance of the courses offered in relation to the program?





Graph 3: How do you rate the competencies in relation to the course content?





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



















Graph 4: How do you rate the relevance of the topics to the Industry?







Graph 8. How do you rate the experiments in terms of their relevatce to the real tife application?





Graph 2: How do you rate the availability of the text and reference books in the market?









Graph 4: How do you rate the treatment of the students by the faculty irrespective of the background of the student (Gender, cast, community, creed etc.) in teaching and evaluation?












Graph 7. How do you rate the programme based on the comfort of your ward in coping with the workload?






